TERM AND CONDITIONS

- The Authorization shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and the rules made there under.
- The Authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer, Authorized by the prescribed authority.
- 3. The Authorized person shall not rent, lend, transfer or otherwise transport the bio-Medical waste without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
- 4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working condition as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
- 5. Bio- Medical waste shall not be mixed with other waste.
- Bio- Medical waste shall be segregated into containers/ bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule-I. Prior to its storage. The Containers shall be labeled as per provisions.
- No untreated bio medical waste shall be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours for in compliance of rule -8 of Bio Medical Waste Rules, 2016.
- 8. You shall submit an annual re
- port to the U.P. Pollution Control Board in form IV by 30th June every year for a period from January to December. And include information about the categories and quantities of Bio Medical waste during the preceding year.
- 10. You shall maintain record related to the generation and segregation of handling of Bio Medical Waste in accordance with rule and guidelines, all records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the Board at any time.
- 11. It is within the power and functions of U.P. Pollution Control Board to modify/ revoke the terms and conditions of Authorization and issued under the Rule 7 (8) of the Bio-Medical waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 12. You are herby directed to comply the stipulated above mentioned conditions and submit the compliance report and steps taken in this regard within a month so that capacity of the facility may be verified failing which the authorization may be revoked and necessary legal proceeding shall be initiated.
- 13. The Bio medical waste shall not be disposed in open place in the premises.
- 14. This authorization is subject to the order of Hon'ble High Court in Criminal revision no. 2671/2008 and Criminal revision no. 2572/2008.
- 15. Strict compliance of Rule 18 and all other provisions of BMW Rule, 2016 must be ensured.
- 16. The CBWTF shall submit the incinerator stack monitoring report analysed by NABL accredited laboratory, giving all parameters as prescribed in BMW Rules-2016, within one month.
- 17. The unit shall strictly comply direction issued by CPCB letter no. F.No.B-31011/ BMW (46.139)/2018 WMD-II/14248 dated 18.12.2018 u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and submit the compliance report within 15 days of receipt of letter.
